### **Phase 1 Situation Analysis**

- A Identify Business Issues and Objectives
  - 1 Describe business requirements, processes and functions
  - 2 Describe and assess current business systems
- B Identify Information Services Issues and Objectives
  - 1 Describe and assess current IS capabilities
  - 2 Assess current and possible technologies
  - 3 Identify Information Services issues
- C Develop Strategic Systems Objectives

### **Phase 2 Business Planning**

- A Analyze Business Plans
  - 1 Review business planning process
  - 2 Describe planned business functions to be automated
  - 3 Outline plans linkages between Business and IS Plans
- B Describe Objectives for the System
  - 1 Identify operational business objectives
  - 2 State management goals for the system
  - 3 Make business forecasts of systems activity and transaction volumes
- C Prepare Strategic Analysis
  - 1 Summarize strategic inputs and assumptions
  - 2 Perform strategic analysis
  - 3 Correlate strategic inputs with business issues
  - 4 Agree on the critical success factors (CSF)

### **Phase 3 Information Services Planning**

- A Develop IS Issues and Requirements
